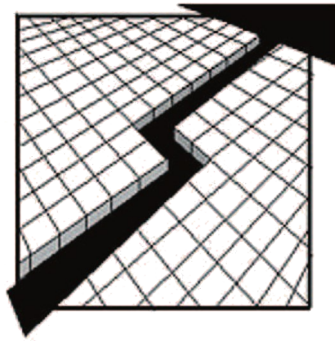


# Break The Gridlock Show And Tell

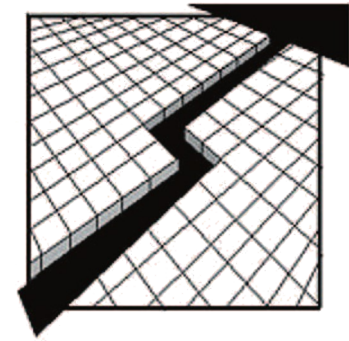
